



DANGEROUS GOODS DRIVERS LICENCE



The Dangerous Goods Drivers Licence course provides knowledge of the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods (7.3) and the responsibilities associated with the transport of dangerous goods. This course leads to the issue of a dangerous goods driver licence which is mandatory for people who operate vehicles that transport dangerous goods in a receptacle with a capacity greater than 500 litres/kilograms.

COURSE CONTENTS

This is a theory based course which includes training and assessment in the following:

- ▶ Statutory requirements and responsibilities
- ▶ Classification and packing of dangerous goods
- ▶ Placarding unit, package loads, containers and vehicles
- ▶ Stowage and segregation
- ▶ HAZCHEM code
- ▶ Emergency equipment
- ▶ Transport procedures and documentation

ASSESSMENT

Students are required to complete the mandatory assessment instrument, consisting of theory and scenario based short answer and multiple choice questions as issued by the Department of Mines and Petroleum.

CERTIFICATION & LICENSING

On successful completion of this course, students are issued a Statement of Attainment for the following unit(s) of competency:

- ▶ TLILIC3013A Preparation to transport dangerous goods by road

This unit forms part of TLI3210 Certificate III in Driving Operations. Once this training is completed, students must complete an online application with the Department of Mines and Petroleum (DMP) to apply for (or renew) their Dangerous Goods Drivers Licence.

Applications must be lodged within 6 months of the date of training. Application information is sent out upon registration for the course, and can also be found on the DMP website at www.dmp.gov.au.
